

where there is a prior conviction and I think this takes that into account, and I hope that copies can be circulated here quickly, but I would support AM1222 as proposed by Senator Hudkins. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, Senator Hudkins, can I ask you a question, please?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hudkins, would you respond, please.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Is this the same bill basically that we talked about earlier?

SENATOR HUDKINS: We've talked about a lot of bills.

SENATOR VRTISKA: I realize that, but I mean this particular one.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Sorry. Okay, let me go back again. LB 353 was the original bill. What that did was to change the penalties for a felony motor vehicle homicide from a Class III, or from a Class IV, excuse me, to a Class III. There were problems with that with Senator Hall. We had the floor debate and I worked with Senator Hall. We changed the language so the language that he wanted is now in the present form.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. I was just curious because I know we did debate that and I knew there was some problem and I was trying to get it clear in my mind and since we don't have a copy it's difficult to...but in concept I am supportive of the legislation and if it's going on faith alone, I would support the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Any other discussion of the amendment by Senator Hudkins? Senator Lindsay.
