Bernard-Stevens' amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the Beutler/Bernard-Stevens amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion of the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Beutler? Waives closing. We will now vote on the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler and Bernard-Stevens' amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the advancement of LB 789 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 789. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Education, whose Chair is Senator Withem, reports LB 683 to General File with amendments. Urban Affairs, whose Chair is Senator Hartnett, reports LB 695 to General File with amendments. And I have amendments to be printed; Senator Hartnett amendments to LB 292; Senator Abboud amendments to LB 627; and Senator Will to LB 575. (See pages 1406-12 of the Legislative Journal.)

Finally, Senators Wesely and Landis would like to add their name to LB 44 as cointroducers, Mr. President. That's all that I have.
