

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yeah, I'd like to correct one thing. That was not Senator Schimek's time that she was yielding to me, that was my time she was yielding back to me. So I want to make that very clear. With that understanding, with the understanding that Senator Schimek has that members of the committee do have a desire to continue to work on the bill, bills are always better, I think, if they come to the floor with the work of a committee put into them. The reason we filed this motion in the first place was that some members of the committee apparently were indicating to...to other members of the body that the bill was going to be killed, that they were going to file a kill motion. There's far too much legislative history put into this bill, far too much taxpayer resources put into this bill to allow that to happen. That is why the original motion was filed. If Senator Schimek feels comfortable that the members of the Government Committee will, in fact, send a product to the floor of the Legislature in the form of LB 76, some time in the near future, I feel that's probably the preferable approach. I do understand, I know there are a lot of new members of the Government Committee this year, and these are somewhat difficult concepts. So if the committee is going to...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR WITHEM: ...spend some time, the next week, and work on the bill, that is a far preferable approach. And, with that understanding, I would withdraw the motion.
