SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Landis, I'm sorry, like so many of these consent bills I haven't had a chance to look at it very close. But I was interested in the language on page 2, lines 10 and 11, which requires the copy of the foreign judgment be filed in the office of the clerk of any court of this state having jurisdiction of such action. I think in order for judgments to be liens on property in this state they have to be filed with the district court. Is...go ahead.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated) ...suggestion from a member of the Bar Association that that language should perhaps be changed to the district court and I had intended on Select File to offer that amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Beutler is...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Finished.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you very much. There is no one else to speak on the bill, Senator Landis, on the closing.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated) ...say that I will make this representation that I will make that change to make sure that what we're talking about is the district court. That is consistent with current practice and Senator Beutler is correct that would be an appropriate thing to do. If I could, I would like to do that on Select File rather than during consent calendar debate.
