PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 240 passes. LB 240A.

CLERK: (Read LB 240A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 240A pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1519-20 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 240A passes. That completes Final Reading. We'll now proceed with Item 7 on the agenda, General File. LB 110.

CLERK: LB 110 has been discussed by the Legislature prior to this time, Madam President, as late as yesterday. A series of amendments have been adopted, the committee amendments I believe are still pending. I have an amendment to the committee amendments. We're back to the committee amendments. I have no further amendments pending to the committee amendments, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I would move the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Does anyone wish to address the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to adopt committee amendments? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 4 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Lindsay, would you like to open on the bill itself?

SENATOR LINDSAY: The bill as it stands now, as I mentioned, is the committee amendments as they've been adopted over the past
