

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, but you're talking about the 11 or whatever, I think it would be good if we knew whether those, if you want to use the word more "liberal" use of drugs, whether those states have had any problems. It seems to me that's information we should have...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...to know whether there's been...

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...proliferation of problems of people that have taken those drugs or not. I mean, I...I have a concern, too, about the rural health care too and...

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...if you could get that information, I think it would be good information for us.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Kristensen, you're next.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I want to respond real briefly to Senator Moore and then, Senator Robinson, I will try to get to yours. You know, the old...the old way to do it is just keep throwing things up onto the board and keep introducing bills and sooner or later something is going to pass just because people get tired of it. And so what Senator Moore is really telling you is we've had all these bills, I've separated them and we've done that, sooner or later we're going to get something. But not once in his speech did you hear him talk about eye care. He talked about history and trying to get something and I think that's real insightful. Now the ability of health care is that we don't have someone that does heart surgery in Minden, Nebraska that isn't any more closer than 130 miles, and if the topical treatments don't work, Senator Wesely said we have to go to something more serious. That's where I make that step, when it becomes more serious is when you should consult with the people that have the training and the experience and that's where residencies and internships come in and not education. And we can put together that book and say we have spent so many hours doing that, I don't know what that class does and I will tell you, for example, when I
