

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President. Senator Horgan has accurately described the amendment and it does parallel the federal act which we are attempting to implement and have to implement at the state level. And so I do think it will provide some clarification that should already be the case, but having it in statute we'll make sure that it is, in terms of what is and isn't covered by the language of the bill. So I would support the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone else wish to speak to the amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Horgan? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Horgan amendment to LB 377. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Horgan's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wesely would move to amend, Madam President. (Wesely amendment appears on page 1262 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President, members. This amendment was brought to me by the bill drafter. It correlates provisions in terms of the fees under this legislation which would be carried out by the State Fire Marshal. There was a bill, LB 251, I understand, that passed and dealt with fees in the Fire Marshal's office. We want to harmonize what was in that bill that's already passed with what's in this bill, in terms of ADA and the Fire Marshal. So, we need this amendment to correlate the two bills. With that, I'd move for adoption of the amendment.
