CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the advancement of LB 124 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've all heard the motion to advance LB 124. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 124 is advanced. LB 124A.

CLERK: I have no amendments to 124A, Senator.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the advancement of LB 124A to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 124A is advanced. LB 406.

CLERK: LB 406, Senator, I have E & R amendments, first of all.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 406.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (Beutler amendment, AM1521, can be found on page 1585 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Could you...is it a short amendment, Mr. Clerk? I can't remember what the amendment is.

CLERK: Well, Senator, it's three-quarters of a page. It's on page 1585 of the Journal. (Read amendment.)

SENATOR BEUTLER: This is to 124? I'm confused, I'm sorry.

CLERK: I'm sorry, we're on 406, that's why you're confused because I was, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh, you switched to 406. I'm sorry. Okay.
