PRESIDENT MOUL: You've all heard the motion to advance LB 126. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 126 is advanced. LB 170.

CLERK: LB 170, I have E & R, Senator.

CLERK: LB 779, I have E & R, first of all, Senator.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: Mr. Clerk, this E & R amendment, this actually does strike the entire comma, or just part of the comma?

CLERK: I think it strikes three-fourths of the comma. (Laughter.)

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: Okay, thank you. I'd move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 779.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. E & R amendments are adopted.
