SENATOR HOHENSTEIN:    I move the advancement of LB 690 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've all heard the motion to advance LB 690. All those in favor please say aye.    Opposed nay.    LB 690 is advanced.    LB 617.

CLERK:    LB 617, no E & R.    Senator Coordsen would move to amend.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN:    Thank you, Madam President, members of the body.    In the E & R process, there was found to be another section of statute that needed some words added to it, basically that this section did not apply to self-storage units.    You remember this was the bill that clarified some language in the Uniform Landlord and Tenant Property Disposal Act.    It came down from bill drafters, they had a question.    This is where the amendment came from and I would urge the adoption of it.    It's clarifying language.    Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Thank you, Senator Coordsen.    Does anyone wish to address this amendment?    Seeing none, we will now vote on the Coordsen amendment to LB 617.    All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay.    Have you all voted?    Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    The amendment is adopted.

CLERK:    I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN:    I move the advancement of LB 617 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've all heard the motion to advance LB 617. All those in favor please say aye.    Opposed nay.    LB 617 is advanced.    LB 719.

CLERK:    LB 719 has no amendments, Senator.
