PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 292A is advanced. LB 121A.

CLERK: LB 121A, offered by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. LB 121A appropriates funds to carry out the limited liability company, which we passed the other day. It's a minimal amount of funds, and I'd ask for the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Does anyone wish to address this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 121A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on LB 121A? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 121A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 121A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Madam President, explanation of vote from Senator Robak and a committee hearing notice from the Natural Resources Committee. That's all that I have.
