SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker and members, LB 544A is a 20,000 dollar Cash Fund appropriation bill. Remember, LB 544 was a bill that basically gives the Department of Administrative authority...Administrative Services oversight over any sort of extended lease plan that extends over a year. And the way this bill would be financed is those sort of purchases made in a lease-purchase arrangement that DAS has oversight over, there would be a nominal fee collected by DAS to perform that service. That is what would fund the bill. As I said, this is 20,000 in Cash Funds. It was estimated it would take one half-time accounting clerk to perform this function in DAS. As I said, it will be funded through the actual whatever sort of leases they make on capital outlays, it will be funded by a very, very, very small fee on what's charged there at the state agency. So with that, I would ask for advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the advancement of LB 544A. Senator Abboud, did you wish to discuss this? Any discussion? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Moore? Waives closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 544A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 544A. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 544A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 544A advances. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?
