

CLERK: No, sir, they were adopted on General File. 1156 was adopted on General File.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and those amendments that I have would have been to that.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, I want to withdraw all of those.

SPEAKER BAACK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Abboud, AM1375, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. Speaker, members, could I get the page number. Is that in the Journal?

CLERK: Page 1526 of the Journal.

SENATOR ABOUD: Thank you. This is the amendment that was discussed on General File that Senator Chambers had brought to the attention of the body over the evaluation of the boot camps after their enactment. What this amendment calls for is that the Judiciary Committee of the Legislature shall annually, beginning July 1, 1997 review the operation of the regimented inmate disciplined units established under this act. And this provides for evaluation by the Judiciary Committee at the Nebraska Legislature. That's the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Discussion of the amendment. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I still have some questions about the boot camp concept but I wanted the Legislature to be in a position from the very beginning, if we decide to move in this direction, to review and evaluate what is being done with reference to this program. And that is why the amendment was drafted which Senator Abboud has before us now. I haven't read this amendment recently so I'd like to ask him a question or two if I may.
