

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Haberman. Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Madam President, very briefly, I think Senator Haberman made a very good point in that one thing he said and that is that in many cases it is the parents and it is the adults and they aren't acting responsibly and it isn't always guns and Senator Haberman is right. But there are so many of these tragedies that could be averted if parents act responsibly and so often, I mean our kids are our most precious resource and we seem to be, they seem to be expendable, they just seem to be expendable anymore. I mean, I don't know why, I don't what has caused our society to be the way it is, but it is and we see the children being killed in Yugoslavia and in Africa and we have...and that's tragic too and it's tragic here on our streets and it happens in Omaha and it happens other places. I noticed in the paper today that there was a young person in Dannebrog, Nebraska that was accidentally shot and killed yesterday. So, Senator Haberman, you're right, it is adults. They need to act more responsibly. You wouldn't act that way with your children, hopefully I wouldn't with mine and none of us would, but it happens and it is a problem. But Senator Chambers' amendment does make the amendment appropriate...less, much, it's a vagueness problem that he has raised and I think he has appropriately addressed it with his amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Any further discussion on Senator Chambers' amendment to Senator Ashford's amendment? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, would you...Senator Chambers waives closing. We'll proceed with the vote on Senator Chambers' amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed. We're voting on Senator Chambers' amendment. Have you all voted? Record. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the Ashford amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. There is another amendment, Mr. Clerk.
