SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Recorder not activated.) ...Chamber. With us as chaplain today we have Pastor Joe Barr, from the Mission Creek United Presbyterian Church from Liberty, Nebraska, from Senator Vrtiska's District. Pastor Barr.

PASTOR BARR: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Pastor Barr. I now call to order the sixty-seventh day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.
