SPEAKER BAACK: You have heard the closing on the advancement of LB 669. We will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 669.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 669 advances. We will now go to LB 669A.

CLERK: LB 669A introduced by Senator Bernard-Stevens appropriates funds to implement LB 669.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Just to note that the fiscal note has been changed. On the Department of Corrections, with the amended version, is 48,000 for what their request would be. No fiscal impact on DPI or Social Services, and would ask that the A bill that reflects what I just mentioned be advanced.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the advancement of LB 669A? Seeing none, we will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 669A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 669A advances. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Senator Warner has amendments to LB 734; Senator Avery to LB 137; Senator McKenzie to LB 389, all asked to be printed. A new resolution, LR 89, by Senator Robak.
