LB 798, 798A, 799A, 799

Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 799.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 799 advances. Inadvertently, I forgot to put the A bills on here. We will go back and do LB 798A right now.

CLERK: Mr. President, 798A by Senator Wesely appropriates funds to implement LB 798, which the body just moved a moment ago.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. This is a bill that will fund the staff to do the review of an individual's assets to see if they are transferred within the period that is considered under the bill. Trying to look here, and it looks like we're talking about \$103,000 in '94-95, \$57,000 in '93-94. With that, I'd ask for advancement of the A bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on LB 798A? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Wesely? He waives closing. We'll now vote on the advancement of LB 798A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 798A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 798A advances. We'll go to LB 799A.

CLERK: LB 799A, offered by Senator Wesely, appropriates funds to implement LB 799.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. LB 799A, again, is to carry out that bill which deals with the waiver for nursing facilities. And, unlike other A bills, this A bill reduces the amount expended, and actually I think the last bill does as well. So these are different kinds of A bills. There are some costs involved, but I forgot to mention on the last bill that there is also a reduction in the General Fund appropriation that is greater in the second year than the cost of the staffing. And likewise, the expected reduction in cost will be \$124,000 next
