Mr. Clerk. I would like to announce that we are just going to go back on the agenda, and we are going to take up LB 500, which was on Select File. We are going to take up LB 500 first, and then we will continue with LB 627 after that, but we are going to take up LB 500 first.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, items for the record.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Select File, Enrollment and Review reports LB 808 to Select File, LB 808A, LB 816, LB 805, and LB 805A, all to Select File, some of those having Enrollment and Review amendments attached. A new A bill, LB 420A by Senator Kristensen. (Read for the first time by title.) That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 2037-42 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will now proceed back to Item 7 on the agenda, Select File, committee priority bills, and LB 500.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 500 was discussed briefly on Select File. Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted. There was pending an amendment by Senator Lindsay. I understand, Senator, you want to withdraw AM1884 now, is that correct?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yes, it is, and if we could substitute, I think it is 19...it is amendment, LaVon Crosby's amendment.

CLERK: It is AM1924, Senator.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right,

SPEAKER BAACK: No objections, so ordered.

CLERK: AM1924 is actually offered by Senator Crosby.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. Senator Lindsay was kind enough to take the Section 5 from LB 224, which I introduced to the Judiciary Committee, to amend into this bill, and let me explain quickly. And last week, you might remember, we had a discussion about this particular amendment.
