LB 203, 203A, 657, 734A

LB 734A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 734A. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 734A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 734A advances. We'll now go to LB 203A.

CLERK: LB 203, introduced by Senator Horgan. (Read title.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Horgan.

SENATOR HORGAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. LB 203A is the A bill to LB 203, which advanc...which was advanced to Select File. As you recall, LB 203 is the bill that Senator Hartnett and I and the Natural Resources Committee are working on to eliminate the retail collection fee and to increase and change the thresholds for the litter fund fee. LB 203A covers the administrative costs incurred by the department by appropriating about \$23,000 from the fee collections to the department for the next...each year for the next two years. And it does not affect the General Fund. This is simply a cash transfer to allow the department to do some computer work and to change their records relating to LB 203, and would ask the body to support the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Horgan. Discussion on LB 203A? Seeing none, we will now vote on the advancement of LB 203A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 203A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 203A advances. We'll now go to Item 9 on the agenda, General File, with the budget package and LB 657.

CLERK: Mr. President, 657 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Wesely and a number of members at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 21 of this year, at that time was referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Appropriations Committee.
