Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I would also like to rise in support of this resolution. The Malcolm High School Band was privileged to go to the Orange Bowl a couple of years ago and I know how much money it takes, how many pizzas we had to sell and how much work it takes on those young people's parts to expand their musical talents, to work on their marching routines and to be accepted in this very prestigious award. SPEAKER BAACK: We will now vote on LR 126. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on LR 126? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 126.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 126 is adopted. We will now proceed to Item 7, General File, special order on the appropriations package and LB 330.

CLERK: 330, Mr. Speaker, was introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, was referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by the Appropriations Committee.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker and member, we've had a good deal of discussion and, well, particularly last week about where the State of Nebraska should go on both its revenue side of the equation and spending side of the equation. There was a lot of discussion last week that if you passed, if you advanced LB 815, if you advanced cigarettes taxes increase, if you advanced increased tax on liquor and things like that where would the money go? At that point in time as we had said, we had a preliminary list in the Appropriations Committee of a recommendation.
