SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: ...build a clinic.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Thank you, appreciate it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Any other discussion on the amendment by Senator Schellpeper? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Schellpeper?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I just want to make a comment that we're not trying to take money away from Omaha and Lincoln, as Senator Ashford thinks we are. We're just trying to help the rural areas, trying to get some doctors to our rural areas. And we would like to have Omaha and Lincoln put some money, once in a while, into rural areas of Nebraska, because they like to keep it in Omaha, they don't want to put it out to the rural areas. This is a way for them to help us just a little bit. Thank you. I would love for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. We will now vote on the Schellpeper amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schellpeper's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, then I have one more amendment. LB 491 and LB 491A are reported to Select File. Those are signed by Senator Hohenstein. Ag Committee has referred back LR 90, a resolution that was referred to them for public hearing. Amendments to be printed to LB 98, LB 677, LB 658.
