SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: This one hasn't been advanced, has it? I would move that LB 719 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 719. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 719 is advanced. That completes Final Reading. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 174 and LB 523, LB 523A, LB 629, LB 510, LB 563, LB 732. Select File is next, LB 292A.
