

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President and members, the amendment is simply this, it is an operative date and the emergency clause, and I would move the adoption of the amendment. The emergency clause is also attached to the A bill to follow. I would move adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the amendment by Senator Hall. Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Hall? He waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hall's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: Move that LB 397 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have the motion to advance. Senator Bromm, did you wish to discuss the advancement?

SENATOR BROMM: I hit the wrong button. No.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the motion to advance LB 397. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 397A.

CLERK: No E & R, Senator, but Senator Hall would move to amend the bill. (Senator Hall's AM 2159 appears on page 2232 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President and members, the amendment is simply the E clause to match it up with the principal bill for purposes of implementing the shift to the Athletic Commission over to the Department of Charitable Gaming for purposes of the new fiscal year July 1. I would move adoption of the E clause to 397A.
