LB 840A, 840, 841A

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move that LB 841A be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 841A. All those in... Senator Pedersen has requested a machine vote and record vote. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2483 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 1 nay, on the advancement of LB 841A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 841A is advanced. LB 840A.

CLERK: LB 840A, no E & R. I do have an amendment. Senator Wesely would move to amend, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President. On the main-line bill, which came from the Appropriations Committee, we are attempting to raise fees on the certificate of need process to help offset the General Fund cost. The question was, does it run through the Cash Fund or the General Fund? On Select File on the main-line bill, LB 840, we decided to run this fee increase and the money through the General Fund, so basically money is appropriated to the Department of Health and then as the fees come in they offset the General Fund versus having it all cash funded based on that. So this amendment reflects the change that we adopted on Select File in the main-line bill and runs the money through the General Fund versus the Cash Fund.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Wesely? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Wesely amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed
