CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Moore would move to amend the bill. (See pages 2483-84 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: This is the amendment now that my memory has been thoroughly jogged, LB 840...this is my amendment to LB 840A. Since we've changed some things in the original bill, we dealt with some PSL language, personal services limitations, because of the \$300,000 reference to personal service limits, what we've now done with funding \$100,000 in LB 541, with Senator Wesely's amendment we're switching the whole thing. Now it's actually going to be general funded but the cash generated is going to come to the General Fund. There is a personal service limit now in LB 541 and there's no need to have any reference to the personal service limit in LB 840A. Originally when we were going to do the whole thing on a Cash Fund basis that needed to be in LB 840A, now we change that already the personal service limitation is contained in LB 541. It is unnecessary to have any reference in LB 840A, and this amendment would strike any reference to the personal service limitation.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Moore? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Moore amendment to LB 840A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move that LB 840A be advanced to E & R for engrossing.
