

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 2491 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 19 nays.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment fails. I will raise the call.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have on the bill is by Senator Lindsay. Senator Lindsay would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Withem would have the option to lay it over.
