Pirsch. Who requested a roll call vote? Senator Chambers. We will proceed with the roll call vote. Please keep your conversations down so the Clerk may hear your responses. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2497-98 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 yyes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 98 advances. I will raise the call. We will now to LB 741. Oh, excuse me, LB 98A. Excuse me.

CLERK: Mr. President, 98A, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator Hohenstein.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move that LB 98A be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 98A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. I have confirmation reports from the General Affairs Committee and Health Committee, signed by the respective Chairs. And Enrollment and Review reports LB 38, LB 389, LB 543, LB 657, LB 669, LB 669A, LB 670, LB 838, LB 839, LB 840, LB 842 and LB 843 as correctly engrossed. SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now go to LB 741.

CLERK: Mr. President, 741, a bill discussed yesterday. At this time, I have no amendments pending to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on LB 741. Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, right now you're being passed out a sheet that will explain what some of the taxes are that are currently being paid on beer, wine and spirits. This is an industry that currently is paying almost \$17 million a year. It's an industry, even though this bill is only...will only increase it about 1.5 million, it's still an
