LB 330, 741, 804

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, and members, thank you, Senator Wesely. I also would just urge you...I think Senator Vrtiska probably put it best, he said it would be rather ironic to vote to tax the kids and not the parents for purposes of this...moving this bill over to Final Reading. I said that on the pop tax, for example, that today I wasn't going to vote for it. That's doesn't mean if some amendments that I may support on LB 330 that are adopted, I will know full well that I have to support that bill when it comes up on Final Reading. I think that's where we should have probably been yesterday afternoon for purposes of these revenue measures. I would hope that we can move this one over as well.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 804.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 804. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.
