CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2567 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 90 passes. LB 430.

CLERK: (Read LB 430 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 430 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2568 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 430 passes. LB 516.

CLERK: Madam President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Landis would move to return the bill for specific amendment. (See AM2518 on pages 2568-69 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, you will find it on your desk. It is a brief one-page amendment to LB 516. In fact, it is the contents of the bill LB 579. Right now we have on General File a bill reported out by the Government Committee five to nothing, and I think with the round endorsement of everybody that serves on that committee, when they heard the public hearing, and we will have a chance to save some money between now and next session if we pass this amendment, which is why I offer it. If you are a municipality and you now do a bond issue, you send to the state a transcript, and this is what it looks like. This transcript has as many as a hundred pages of Xeroxed statutes. It also turns up the terms of the bonds and the like, and this is an old obligation to send it in. When they send it in, we put it in big boxes over in the Auditor's Office. Then we microfiche them and keep them in the permanent record of the state. We did this for a number of years because years ago they used to have municipal bonds which
