

and would have, I think, tied our hands with respect to being a state open to doing business with franchise...the sales of franchises. For that reason, I would urge the adoption of the amendment, the readvancement of the bill and moving on to the more meatier issues of the day.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Landis. We'll now vote on the motion to return. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the motion to return to Select File.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill has been returned to Select File. Now on the amendment itself, Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Ask for the adoption of the amendment as explained.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion of the amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I would move to advance LB 218 to E & R for engrossing.
