

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 717 on Select File. E & R amendments first of all, Senator.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 717.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, those opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have is by Senator Hall. Senator, I have AM2014 in front of me.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Senator, excuse me, Mr. Clerk, do you have an amendment to that amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.

SENATOR HALL: If we could go to that, please.

CLERK: Senator Hall would move to amend his amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. This amendment is found in the Journal on page 2188. It's listed as an amendment to LB 345. It is the half cent sales tax for the City of Omaha. It reads like this. It says a city of the metropolitan class is hereby authorized to increase for no more than 12 consecutive months any city sales and use tax existing on the effective date of this act imposed pursuant to this section by an amount not to exceed one-half of one percent if the governing body of the city adopts an ordinance approving such increase. The proceeds from the tax imposed by this subsection shall be placed in the fund for improvements to and renovations of city-owned entertainment, convention, and sports facilities. This subsection shall terminate on October 1, 1994.
