

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. Speaker, because of our rules, of our internal rules and not constitutional rules, we suspend the rules and read these bills today. I simply make that motion and ask the body to suspend the rules so we can read these bills.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the motion to suspend the rules? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend rules to permit reading today of Final Reading bills.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed with Final Reading. Members, please take your seats. We still are on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 804 with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 804 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 804 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2704 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 804 with the emergency clause attached passes. We'll go to LB 804A with the emergency clause.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 804A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 804A with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2704-05 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 804A passes with the emergency clause attached. We'll go to LB 815 with the emergency clause.
