PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Chaplain Harland Johnson.

CLERK: Madam President, bills read on Final Reading Thursday, June 3, were presented to the Governor at 11:45 p.m. (Re: LB 453, LB 453A, LB 520, LB 520A, LB 597, LB 597A, LB 505, LB 505A, LB 734, LB 734A)

Communications from the Governor. Engrossed LB 739 was received in my office June 9, 1993. The bill was signed by me June 4 and delivered to the Secretary of State, and there is an accompanying message with that signing. In addition, engrossed LB 90, LB 430, LB 598, LB 237, LB 413, LB 697, LB 50 and LB 220 were received in my office on June 1 and engrossed legislative bills LB 292 and LB 292A on June 3. These bills were signed by me on June 4 and delivered to the Secretary of State.

LR 272 by Senator Ashford and a number of the members will be laid over. Pursuant to its introduction, the Speaker directs that LR 272 be referred to the Exec Board for referral to the appropriate committee. That's all that I have, Madam President.
