PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 516 passes. Before we proceed, I would like to call the senators' attention to the area under the south balcony. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 247, LR 248, LR 264, LR 265, LR 266, LR 268, LR 269, and LR 270, and LB 389, LB 669, LB 669A, LB 117, LB 117A, LB 203, LB 203A, LB 397, LB 397A, LB 564, LB 564A, LB 719, LB 725, LB 725A. We will now return to LB 389.

CLERK: Madam President, when the Legislature bracketed LB 389, Senator Beutler had a motion pending to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I would withdraw this motion and all other motions I filed.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The motions are withdrawn.

CLERK: (Read LB 389 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 389 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I'd ask for a check in and a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Would the senators please check in. Would the senators please check in. Senator Bromm, Senator Jones, please check in. Senator Beutler, Senator Wickersham, Senator Lynch, please check in. We'll proceed with roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2800 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes...Senator Beutler.
