SENATOR PEDERSEN: And then making another person, still leaving the total number at ten.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And adds that person for the administrative level.

SENATOR PEDERSEN: Yes, yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, got it. Thank you.

SENATOR PEDERSEN: You bet.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Pedersen, would you like to close? Closing is waived. The issue before the body is the amendment, the Pedersen amendment to the committee amendments to LB 461. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Pedersen amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The amendment to the committee amendment is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Pirsch. Do you wish to speak to the committee amendments?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Madam President. Just to clarify, we now have taken instead of the Director of Correctional Services and his or her designee, we have broadened that to one person who is serving as an administrator or jailer responsible, and Senator Lindsay tells me that that essentially would be Lincoln, Omaha, Sarpy County. Is that correct, Senator Lindsay?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I believe so, and, Carol, I want to clarify I think what you said. Actually, what this has done is with the addition of the Pedersen amendment, which I think is a good...(interruption)

SENATOR PIRSCH: I haven't gotten there yet.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I'm just doing the committee amendment.
