LR 284

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of LR 284.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LR 284 is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion is one offered by Senator Hartnett. It would request permission to cancel a hearing, but will require a rule suspension, therefore, Senator Hartnett would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 13 to permit cancellation of a hearing scheduled for next Tuesday, February 1.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam President and members of the body, as the Clerk said, I'd like to suspend Rule 3, Section 13 to prevent (sic) the cancellation of hearing on LB 1191 scheduled for February the 1st, 1994 for the Urban Affairs Committee. We had a typo error. It should have been LB 119; LB 1191 is an appropriation bill, so we can't have a hearing, so I'd ask for the...mistake, we made a type mistake, so I'd ask this motion be adopted.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Hartnett, would you like to close? Closing is waived. The issue before the body is the motion to permit cancellation of a hearing. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the suspension of the rules to permit cancellation of hearing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion to suspend rules is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, as a result of that action, Urban Affairs offers notice of hearing, cancellation of hearing. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LBs 853-859 as correctly engrossed, those signed by Senator McKenzie as Chair. (See page 511 of the Legislative Journal.) And I also have hearing notice from the Natural Resources Committee. That is signed by Senator Beutler as Chair. That's all that I have.
