SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is the adoption of the Pirsch amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Pirsch's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Pirsch amendment is adopted. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question then is the advancement of LR 29 to E & R Initial. Is there any discussion? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, just one very brief comment. Senator Pirsch and I have been over there in a no-fire zone discussing some aspects of the bill, and the area of forfeitures is what really does concern me a great deal, more so than even some of the other things that she is trying to put into the bill, in the constitution. She is going to do some additional considering of this matter in her own way and under circumstances that she will determine, so with that understanding that she and I have, I am not going to discuss the bill any further at this point or offer any other amendments at this point. But, Senator Pirsch, this is not saying that I am just backing away altogether. I am hoping something can be worked out. But at this point, I am sticking by what I said, my comment would be brief. I've made it, that's it.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any further discussion on the advancement of LR 29 to E & R Initial? Seeing none, Senator Pirsch, you are recognized for closing.

SENATOR PIRSCH: My closing will be brief, please advance LR 29CA. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the closing. The question is, shall LR 29CA be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
