bill, as Senator Schellpeper stated, with the two amendments that have been adopted are basically clean up. There is little substantive measures that are in the bill. I would, again, just reiterate that the issue of the lease arrangement where I raised the concern earlier on the amendment, Senator Schellpeper has agreed to take a look at that between now and Select File. I appreciate that. Again, I would urge the body to advance the bill. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Hall. Any further discussion? Senator Schellpeper, there is none, do you care to close?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: No, I think I pretty well explained it in my opening, and the committee amendments are also very important to the bill, but it does help the people that are involved in bingo currently. I will be glad to work with Senator Hall if he has any problem before Select File. But, mainly, they are just technical, but it does allow mainly to advertise bingo and that's what they really wanted to do. So I would move for the advancement of LB 694.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the closing. The question is the advancement of LB 694 to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 694.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1025 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Pirsch and Hall. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to Urban Affairs Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. LB 1025 would require applicants, as a condition of employment, to submit to the City of Omaha, and this applies to them only at this time, a full set of his or her fingerprints along with the authorization to forward the prints to the FBI to check for criminal history record information.
