SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Fisher, I understand you're handling this bill.

SENATOR FISHER: Mr. Speaker, I also have acquired Senator Bernard-Stevens' sore throat, so this is going to be rather quick and short. This bill was heard in hearing, LB 872, and the gist of the whole bill is that there should be a quorum present when the Public Service Commissioners meet. And for your information, there's five of them, that means three out of the five should be there. I think that...I understand that they are now...they were currently discussing this issue and making one of their own rules to make that present...make that rule present, that they do have three out of the five. Also, they may be attended, should be get into teleconferencing, that can be counted as a presence. So, with not much more, if there's any questions, I'll be glad to answer them. Otherwise I'd ask that you advance this bill.
