PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. The issue before the body is the advancement of LB 254. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, Madam President, excuse me, on the advancement of LB 254.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 254 advances. We have several bills and legislative resolutions that do not have amendments and we will move to those bills at eleven-thirty and advance those bills if they do not have amendments. I am going to read those bills off, so that if you have any amendments to make to these bills, you should do so yet in the next hour. LR 15CA, LR 2CA, LB 414, LB 594, LB 407, LB 490, LB 416, LB 1019, LB 1027, LB 934, LB 987, LB 608, LB 608A, LB 211, LB 211A, LB 398, LB 611, LB 451, LB 241, LB 424, LB 630, LB 819, LB 132, LB 695, LB 642, and LB 642A. We will go to those bills at eleven-thirty. We move now to LB 511. We have some items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Education Committee reports LB 1311 to General File with amendments. That is signed by Senator Bohlke. Judiciary reports LB 888 to General File, LB 1326 General File, LB 1329 General File, LB 518 General File with amendments, likewise with LB 1010, LB 1308. LB 1142 and LB 1332 reported indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Lindsay. Natural Resources reports LB 1031 to General File. That is signed by Senator Beutler. Communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Read. Re: LB 846-859.) Senator Bernard-Stevens has amendments to LB 291, LB 647, LB 681 to be printed.
