SPEAKER WITHEM: The Clerk has brought to my attention something the body needs to know about this bill. This bill did fail to advance once already on Select File. Your memories probably wouldn't remember back to, other than Senator Byars probably recalls that, the memories may not go back to last session. So if this fails to advance the second time, it will stand as indefinitely postponed. The question then is the advancement of LB 100 to E & R engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed. A machine vote has been requested. Please vote aye if you want to vote to advance, vote nay if you choose not to. Have you all voted? There is a request for a record vote. Mr. Clerk, would you record the vote, please?

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 776 of the Legislative Journal.) 12 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is not advanced. It stands as indefinitely postponed. I would like to recommend, I would like to introduce a former colleague of ours under the south balcony. We have former Senator Tom Fitzgerald. Tom, would you stand to be recognized. Items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, thank you. Transportation Committee, who is chaired by Senator Kristensen, reports LB 982 to General File, LB 1040 to General File, LB 864 General File with amendments, LB 1044, LB 1317 to General File with amendments, LB 869 indefinitely postponed, LB 870, LB 873, LB 926, LB 1032, LB 1259 indefinitely postponed, those reports signed by Senator Kristensen. Judiciary Committee reports LB 1173, LB 1307, and LR 296CA as indefinitely postponed, those signed by Senator Lindsay. Enrollment and Review reports LB 868, LB 1017, LB 941, and LB 889 to Select File, some having Enrollment and Review amendments. (See pages 776-78 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have a gubernatorial appointment, be referred to Reference. Priority bill designation, Senator Pedersen has selected LB 1002, and Senator Day has selected LB 1207. That is all that I have, Mr. President.
