avenue. And this is designed to at least get those entities working together to try to determine what is best for the young person. Again, as I indicated, I have no interest in simply making it easier for schools to dump kids out onto the street. What I do have a concern is that if young people are not able to be in the schools, because of their behavior, they ought not be there. But the system ought to be doing something to deal with those kids problems and the problems that they cause and not simply waiting for those to escalate, to become major, major concerns. So that's the rationale of the bill. Again, thank Senator Pedersen for probably a better explanation of how this would actually work than I was able to give. I would urge you to adopt the amendment, and with that, try to switch roles here again and indicate that it would probably be a convenient time now to break and take up the Ashford amendment. So, Mr. President, I would ask that this retain its place on the agenda, but be temporarily set aside while we wait for the Ashford amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Withem. We will follow that order. But first, Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Enrollment and Review reports LB 971, LB 883, LB 883A, LB 942, LB 980, LB 1015, LB 967, LB 929, and LB 1106, LB 1106A, LB 1116 to Select File, some of those having Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Revenue Committee reports LB 1175, General File; LB 37, General File with amendments; LB 885, General File with amendments; and LB 871, LB 959, LB 960, LB 976, LB 1072, LB 1090, LB 1144, LB 1154, LB 1190, LB 1229, and LB 1283 and LB 1284 as indefinitely postponed. Those are reports all signed by Senator Warner. Retirement Committee reports LB 1287 to General File with amendments. Senator Wesely, as Chair of Health and Human Services, has selected LB 817 and LB 1210 as committee priority bills. Senator Dierks, LB 933 and LB 1058 as the Agriculture Committee priority bills.
