

SENATOR HALL: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: The house is under call. All members, please return to the Chamber, record your presence, the house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Members, if you would report in, return to your seats and check in, the house is under call. Senators Schimek, Vrtiska and Robinson, if you would please check in. Thank you very much. Senators Chambers, Senator Pirsch, Senator Elmer, Senator Hillman, Senator Haberman, Senator Jones, if you would check...Thank you very much. We're looking for Senator Chambers and Senator Haberman. If you would return to the Chamber, record your presence, the house is under call. Senator Haberman is the only one that we are looking for right now. Senator Withem, fine, go ahead? Mr. Clerk, roll call vote has been requested. Please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 804 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The Withem amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, priority bill designation, Senator Moore selected LB 957; Senator Crosby, LB 903; Senator Wesely has amendments to LB 827, LB 823, LB 498 to be printed; Senator Pirsch to LB 277. Senator Bromm also has priority bill designation, LB 944. Mr. President, Senator Abboud wants to announce an Exec Session of the Business and Labor Committee at one-thirty, Room 2022. Executive Board will meet upon adjournment in Room 2102 for purposes of an Exec Session. Exec Board at noon in 2102; Business and Labor at one-thirty in 2022.
