PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Hall, your light is next. Question has been called. Do I see five hands? There are five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Debate is ceased. Senator Schellpeper, do you wish to close?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam President and members. Senator Kristensen is exactly right, that's what this part of the bill...we're just talking about Section 7. And so what we're attempting to do here is just saying that if you sign this it will be for just one year instead of two years, that they can actually come back on...that you actually sign this agreement. But there will still be this other four years that you can go back, that's current law. We're not affecting the current law at all, we're not touching that part of it, just this one part would go from two years to one year. So I would ask that the bill be returned to just change from two years to one year. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. The question before the body is the motion to return LB 640 to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 3 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The bill is returned to Select File. Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam President and members. I think the bill or the amendment has been fairly well discussed. I don't want to take a lot of time this morning. Once again we're just changing on page 6, line 16, from two years to one year. I think it's all been explained what we're attempting to do. We're not taking away that four year right, we're just this one section is all, we go from two years to one year. I would move for the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.
