It could be a contractor, it could be any number of examples, so it applies to all those circumstances. But, in any event, it's quite accurate to say that it ends up double taxation in that that...for the...since January 1, because they would have paid a fee, plus they are now paying both state and federal tax at the pump.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Warner. Any discussion on the advancement of LB 1160? Seeing none, is there a closing, Senator Warner? Senator Warner waives closing. The question then is the advancement of LB 1160. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1160.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1160 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Banking Committee reports LB 1067 to General File with amendments, signed by Senator Landis. Transportation Committee reports LB 1095 to General File. That's signed by Senator Kristensen. Enrollment and Review reports LB 683, LB 1129, LB 1250, LB 1275 to Select File, some of those having Enrollment and Review amendments. New A bill, LB 1287A, by Senator Wickersham. (Read LB 1287A for the first time by title.) That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 903-07 of the Legislative Journal.)

Let me share with the body my intentions when we set today's agenda would be to debate LR 319 the rest of this morning or assuming it takes the rest of the morning, breaking for lunch, recessing until one-thirty, coming back at one-thirty, continuing our discussion on LR 319, and then if there is time after we conclude discussion on 319, to return to General File. At this point, we would return to General File, LB 1002. With that, let me also announce that, pursuant to Rule 4, Section 5, we have had a request from a member requesting that the adoption of LR 319 require a vote of a majority of the elected members. So it will take a vote of the majority of the elected members to constitute approval of LR 319. With that, Mr. Clerk.
