SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone not activated) ...gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. As we begin this our thirty-sixth legislative day, we're pleased this morning to have our chaplain, Pastor Deb Kevern, from the Presbyterian Church of the Master in Omaha. If you would please all rise.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: A quorum is present. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, on page 872, line 37, strike the word "select" and insert "General"; and on page 872, line 38, strike "E & R" amendment and insert "Standing Committee". That's all that I have.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Those corrections will be noted. Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports LB 1337 and LB 1160 to Select File with E & R amendments attached. Enrollment and Review reports they have examined and engrossed LB 188 and find the same correctly engrossed; LB 211, LB 211A, LB 611, LB 642, LB 929, LB 967, LB 1106, LB 1106A, LB 1116, all reported correctly engrossed. A communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Re: Signing of LB 407, LB 416, LB 451, LB 490, LB 934, LB 1019, LB 1027, LB 424, LB 608, LB 608A on March 3, 1994.) And a second communication.
