Senator Withem, would you like to close?

SPEAKER WITHEM: I would waive closing. Just urge adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Withem amendment to LB 683. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Withem amendment to LB 683. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Withem amendment is adopted. Anything...no.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Madam Chairman. I would move LB 683 be advanced to E & R Engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 683 to E & R Engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items to read into the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Senator Robinson has amendments to LB 1002; Senator McKenzie, LB 511; Senator Wehrbein and McKenzie, LB 984; Senator Withem to LB 1290. I have a motion from Senator Abboud, as Chair of Business and Labor, to move for the introduction of two new bills. And Senator Lindsay would like to add his name to LB 665. SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Senator Withem, would you like to adjourn us?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, I move that we adjourn until 9:00 a.m. tomorrow morning, March 9th.
