SENATOR CROSBY: Tell that to Lana Wagner's husband and family. And if you people in Omaha, tell that to Sam Greenberg's family that passing this law won't bring them back...bring him back. That will make them feel real good, I'm sure. And what I'm asking of you...all I'm asking is 30 votes today to bring it up and place it on General File. We have still three more times to do something about it. Thank you very much for your time. I appreciate your staying a little late.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Crosby. It appears to me from the board as all unexcused members are here. Is that correct, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The introducer has requested a roll call vote. Call the roll, please.
