**CLERK:** I have a quorum present, Madam President.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Thank you. Are there any announcements?

**CLERK:** There are, Madam President. I have Transportation Committee reports, reporting LB 1062, LB 1081, LB 1102, LB 1104 and LB 1105. Those reports are indicative of the indefinite postponement of those bills by the Transportation Committee. That's all that I have at this time, Madam President.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 328, LR 329, LR 327, LR 326, LR 325 and LR 324. We move now to General File and LB 1290.

**CLERK:** Madam President, LB 1290 was a bill introduced by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was referred to the Education Committee for public hearing. It has been discussed on February 23 and again on February 28. Amendments to the bill have been adopted. There is a motion to bracket the bill until March 2. I do have an amendment pending.
