PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Well, I would concur that I don't know why I signed the appropriations bill, it just kind of happened that way. And so I'm not trying to take credit for anymore spending than I have to in this job, but the one thing...the reason this bill was...we asked and the Speaker included in part of the package is it's kind of a government management thing, but it allows the government to operate hopefully more efficiently and save us some money by pooling all those things together and doing it all in one function like this. And so it makes some sense, that's why we advanced it and ask that it be part of our package. So, with that, I'd ask for adoption...advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Is there any further discussion on LB 1006? Seeing none, Senator Schimek, would you like to close on the bill? No-closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1006 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance Senator Schimek's bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1006 is advanced. We move now to LB 1006A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, 1006A was introduced by Senator Moore. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Madam President. This is Senator Schimek's A bill with my name on it. And what the A bill does is simply give revolving fund authority to DAS to allow the different agencies to pay into them to do their training. So it's a revolving fund authority in the A bill. And, with that, I'd ask for the advancement of the A bill.
